

At this time, the CCA has discontinued its grant program for Lite Rocks. However, the TCA is still offering grants for purchase of Lite Rocks. The funding for this program comes out of our Junior Development fund which is funded by the TCA Junior Lottery.

How to apply for a "Lite" Rock Grant - A grant amount not to exceed \$500.00 per sheet for the purchase of one set (16 stones) of "Lite ROCKS" not including shipping and taxes.

- Club must be a member in good standing of the TCA

Club must apply in writing to the TCA care of Elizabeth Woolnough at ewoolnough@publicnet.ca

- Priority will be given to clubs who
- Are purchasing their first set of "Lite ROCKS" and starting up a program
- Have some sets of "Lite ROCKS" but not enough for all sheets of ice
- Have not recently received a TCA grant (each club applying in a single year receives one set before a second set is awarded to the same club in the same year.) (Clubs may apply for multi sets)
- Annually the TCA Executive will determine the total amount to be budgeted each year for "Lite ROCKS" grants. (\$1,000 in 2006-07)
- Once approved the club will be notified in writing.

Club can then purchase "Lite ROCKS" from Canada Curling Stone for the current cost

Once the TCA receives the club's paid invoice the TCA will rebate the club \$500.00 (\$500.00 saving to the club)
