Skip - Nancy Harrison, vice - Jeannie Davies, Second - Terri Martyniuk and Lead - Luann Gray from Burlington claimed the title over Jan Carwardine's team from Leaside. The Senior trophy was won by Pat Reid and her team of Pat Lee, Liz Mihaly and Jeff Bamford from Leaside over Delaine Payton and her team from Scarborough.
